

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. WHAT IF I ARRIVE AT BELMONT EARLY & WISH TO GO FOR A SAIL?

A. As noted above, the Flying 11 Nationals will be held at Belmont 16s the week prior finishing up on Friday 2nd January. Therefore, anyone wishing to go for a sail during this time we ask to utilize the lawn on the Western side of the club and do not use the club rigging lawn or car park. No trailers are permitted to be stored in car park prior to Sunday 4th January. Competitors that wish to go for a sail on Saturday 3rd January are asked to remove their trailer from car park.

Q. WHAT IF I NEED URGENT ACCESS TO SOMETHING IN MY TRAILER WHEN RIGGING?

A. Your trailer will be within reach of your boat, designated trailer parking is within the grounds of the Belmont 16ft Sailing Club car park and a mere 100 metres from Eastern Rigging area and 200 metres from Middle rigging area.

Q. IS THERE A SAIL MAKER IN THE AREA FOR REPAIRS?

A. Yes Belmont 16s is fortunate to have multiple sail makers in the area and are involved with Skiff sailing

Q. WHERE CAN I BUY BOAT PARTS & MAINTENANCE ITEMS?

A. RTM at Bennetts Green is closest. In addition, Whitworths Marine is located at Lambton NSW, approximately 25-30 minutes away. Marine Outlet located at Morriset, NSW.

Q. ARE THERE ANY OTHER PUBLIC CAR PARK & BOAT RAMP FACILITIES THAT WE CAN USE FOR RIGGING?

A. There are other public areas along the foreshore that may be suitable for rigging. However, we cannot guarantee security throughout the week and or parking availability.



Q. IS THERE A COURTESY BUS RUNNING THROUGHOUT THE WEEK FOR EASE OF PARKING AND EVENTS?

A. Yes. A courtesy bus will be available throughout the week, allowing sailors, spectators, volunteers, and supporters to leave their cars at home and help ease parking during this busy period. You can book the courtesy bus by texting 0418431731.
