Rigging Area

We have two main rigging areas available: however as it is also peak trading period for the club, part of the larger area to the east of the main clubhouse will be utililised and designated as a car park. Therefore Flying 11s are permitted to rig on the concrete apron in middle rigging area and the area in front of the Brian Ellis Boat Shed. Boats are also permitted to rig and launch on the Council land to the west of the main clubhouse.

RIGGING AREA RESTRICTIONS

Please note that no boats are permitted to rig in the Emergency Zone (highlighted in red on diagram below). This area must remain clear to ensure access for emergency vehicles and all club rescue resources.

Do not rig on paved driveways or in front of the loading dock. Trucks must have ample room to reverse into the loading dock, so please ensure the area is kept clear. Additionally, please avoid blocking any driveways.

Please rig on the concrete apron closest to the water and keep the boat ramp clear for launching and retrieval. Your cooperation helps keep everyone safe and operations running smoothly.
